Cellular Telephone Policy

The use and possession of cell phones is strictly prohibited at St. Raphael School during the school day. Students with cell phones in school must keep them turned off, not in silent or vibrate mode, and stowed in their backpacks until they leave the school premises. Providing a cell phone for use by another student is a violation of this policy. Violation of this policy will result in the issuance of a detention and confiscation of the phone. A parent/guardian must make arrangements to pick up the confiscated phone from the Principal or Assistant Principal. A student violating this policy gives up any right to privacy in the memory contained on the cell phone making it subject to search to determine if any other violations have occurred, i.e. cheating, bullying, inappropriate language or photos, etc. (Please refer to Saint Raphael School Code of Conduct posted at the school website.)

I have read and discussed with my child/children this Cellular Telephone Policy, his/her/their responsibility to comply with this policy, and the consequences for the failure to do so. I understand this policy and agree to join in assuring my child's/children's compliance and will support any disciplinary decisions made by school authorities.
