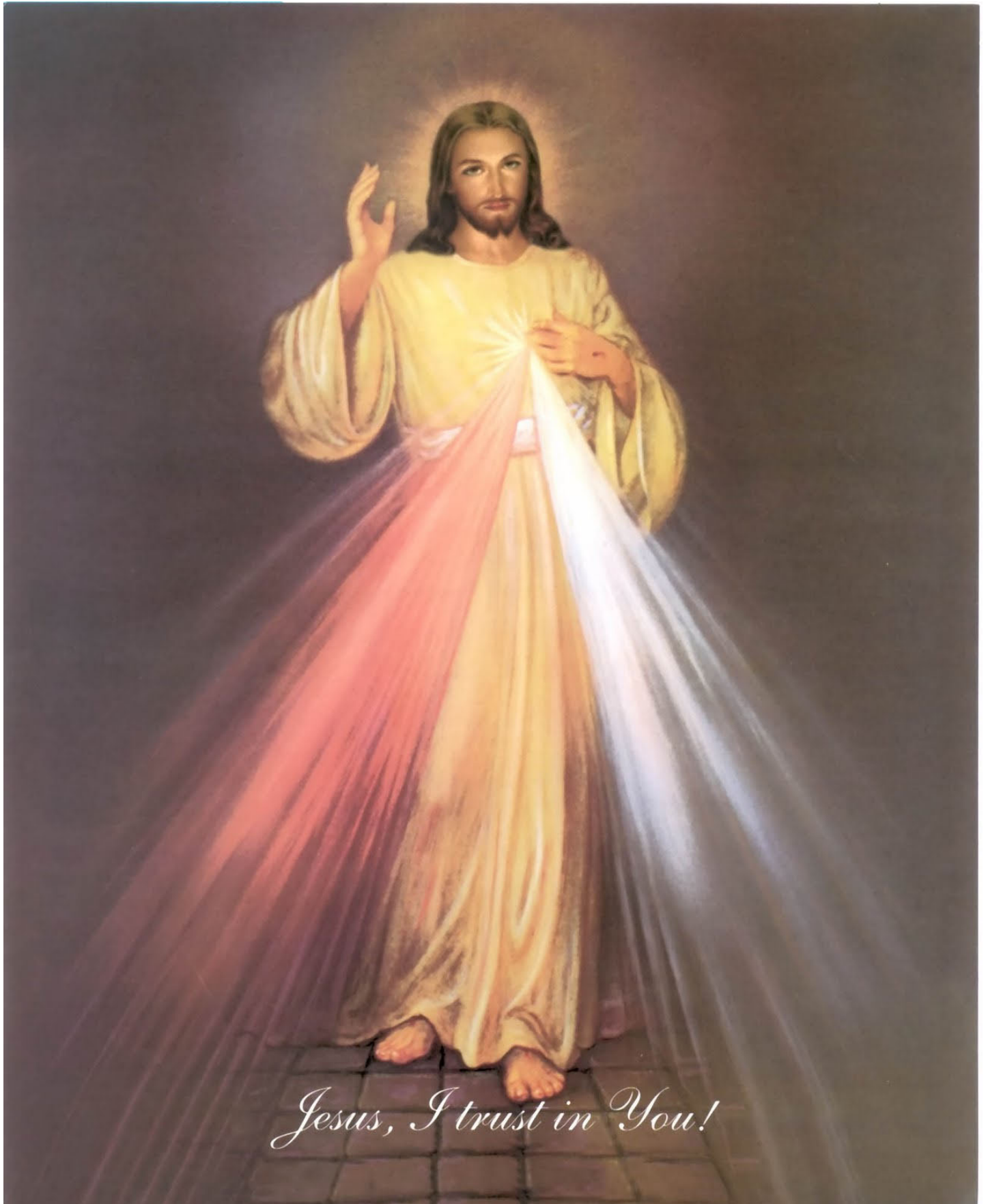

LEGION OF MARY

Do you have two hours a week for service to our parishioners at the direction of our pastor? If so, the **Legion of Mary** may be right for you! Our Legion meets every Tuesday for one hour from 10:00 am until 11:00 am in the Tobit Room. We pray the Rosary, read from our handbook, report on our works, hear a reflection from our spiritual director, and have a short business meeting followed by a closing prayer. During the school year, we perform an hour of service each week – sometimes more – by sending cards to bereaved families or to parents of newly baptized children. 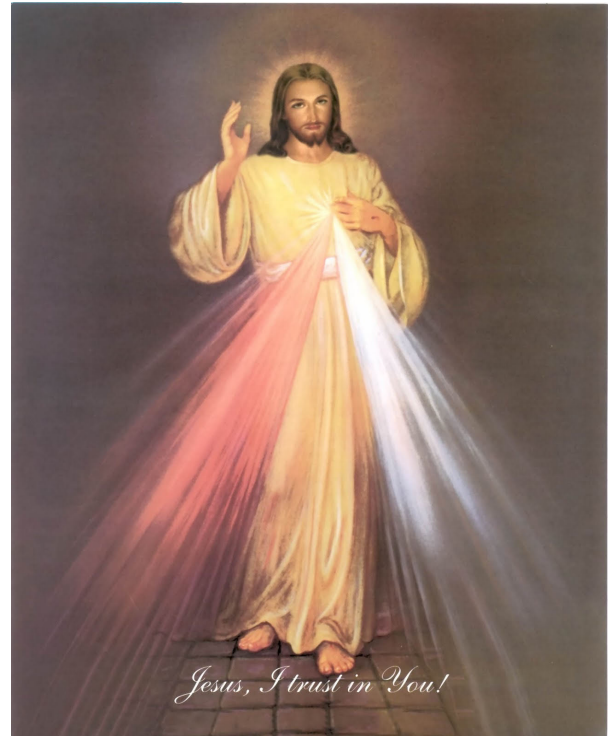

Divine Mercy Sunday



This weekend, Divine Mercy Sunday, April 12th, at 3:00 pm in the PAC, there will be a prayer service that includes Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet, a Homily, and a Benediction.

History and devotion: In 1931, Jesus appeared to St. Faustina Kowalska dressed in white with one hand raised in blessing and the other hand on his heart where two rays of red and white lights came out. Throughout the 1930's, Jesus spoke and appeared to St. Faustina and asked her to make the message of Divine Mercy known. He told St. Faustina that He will pour out great mercy to those who trust in Him. He also told her about great graces for those who will recite the Divine Mercy Novena (starts on Good Friday) and participate in the Divine Mercy Sunday Service (Sunday after Easter Sunday). He encourages souls to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet for the sick and the dying, and especially at the 3 o'clock hour (the time of his death).
